Note:

1. MIT charges a 10% fund transaction fee for off-campus RAs billed via invoice or purchase order. On-campus (MIT) RA's may be subject to full MIT overhead of 55.1%. Additionally, sub-contracts may be subject to full MIT overhead of 55.1% and your institutions's indirect fee which would apply to the first \$25,000 of the sub-contract cost.
2. Electronic fund transfers from Partners Healthcare Paymode incur an additional 1.5% fee
3. Faculty will cover 47% of Research Assistant tuition & MIT subsidy covers 53% of tuition.
4. MIT tuition subsidy applies only to RA appointments and not to fellowships.
5. Stipend paid to student monthly over 4.5 months
6. HST MD students may apply for summer research support through various sources. Contact the HMS Office of Scholarly Engagement (OSE) for list of resources or visit their website at <https://meded.hms.harvard.edu/about-scholarly-engagement>
7. Summer PI funding done through off-campus lab. MIT does not normally process invoices, unless it is for an on-campus lab or existing Billing Agreement.
